


Table Size	Playing Surface	Ideal Room Sizes Using a Standard Cue
7'	39" x 78"	12'11" x 16'2"
8'	44" x 88"	13'4" x 17'0"
9'	50" x 100"	13'10" x 18'0"
10'	56" x 112"	14'2" x 18'10"
12'	70" x 140"	15'4" x 21'2"

PLANNING TIPS:

- ●1 Square = 1 Foot
- The chart shows ideal room sizes. You can get away with less space by using a short cue for that tight spot.
- If space is limited, leave more space at the foot of the table since that's where most play occurs during the average game.
- •Don't worry about a post we can help plan your room around it.
- Other things to consider fireplaces, direct sunlight, forced air vents, fluctuating humidity levels, windows and mirrors.
- Hang your billiard lamp approximately 32 inches above the table's playing surface.
- Allow approximately 58" from the wall to the playing surface for a full length cue.
